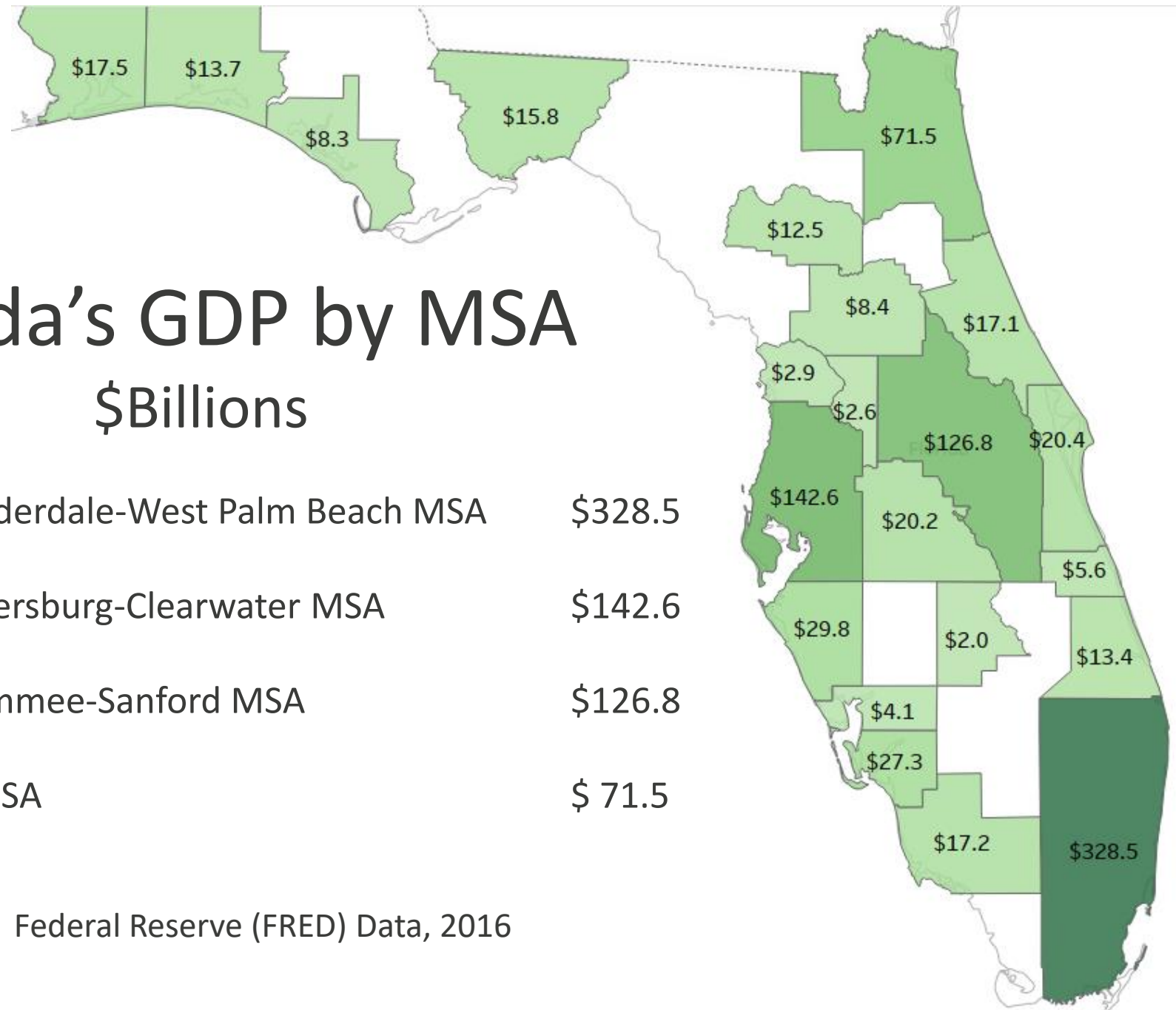

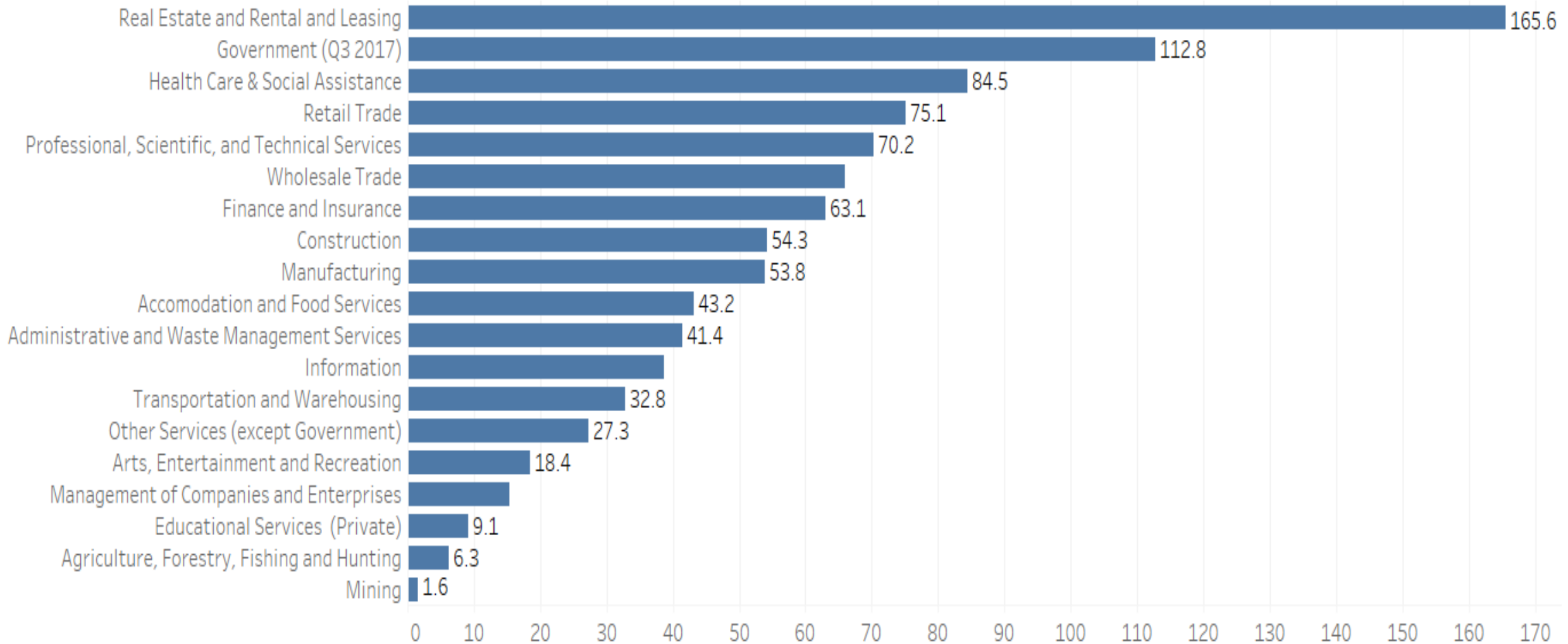

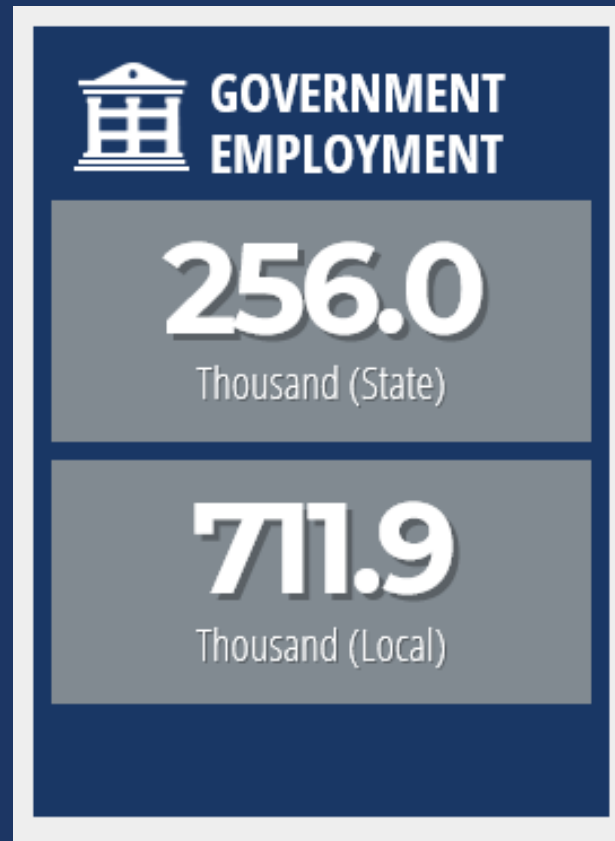
# Florida's GDP by Industry – Q1 2018 (\$Billion)

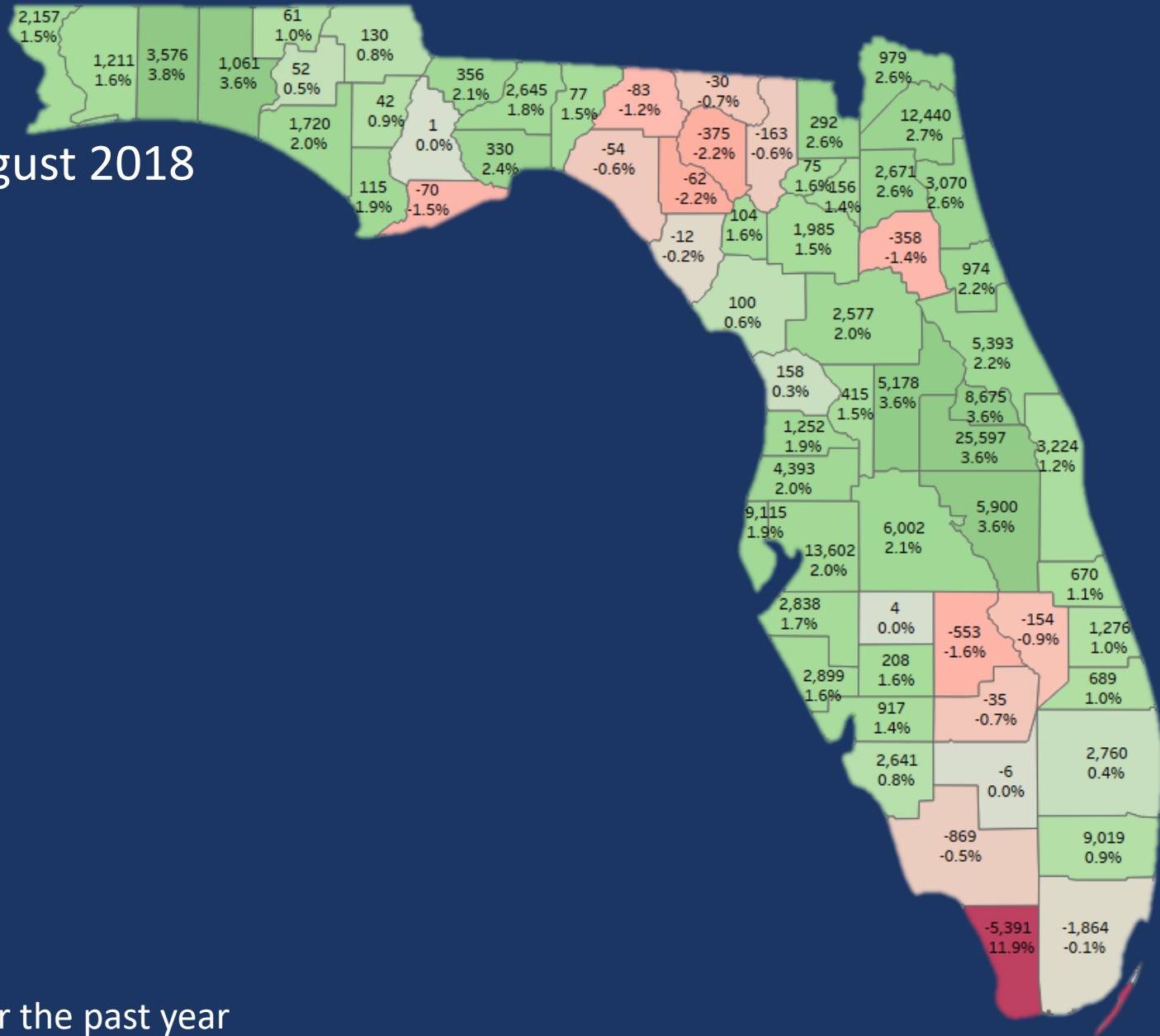

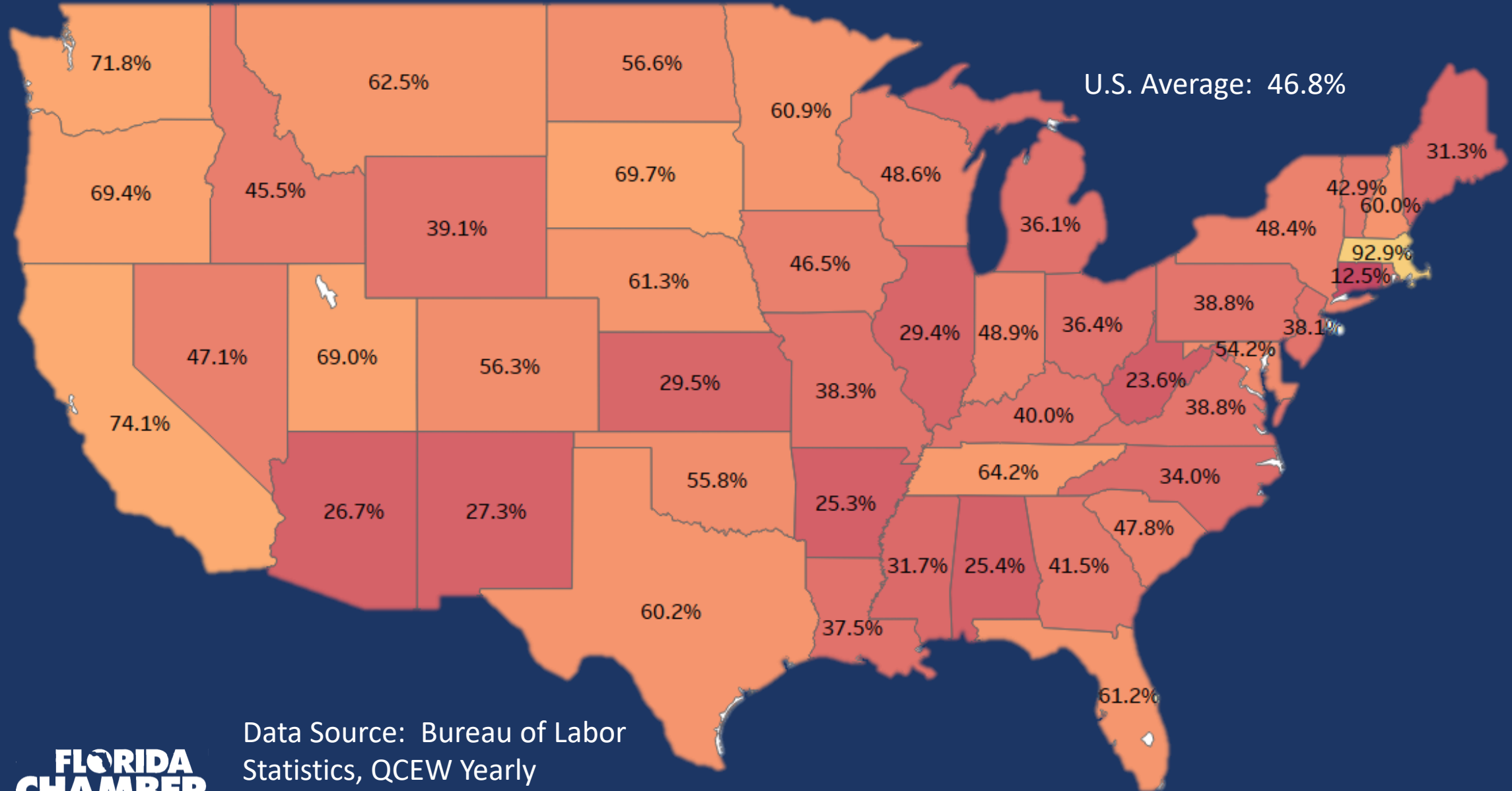

16 Florida Counties Lost Jobs over the past year

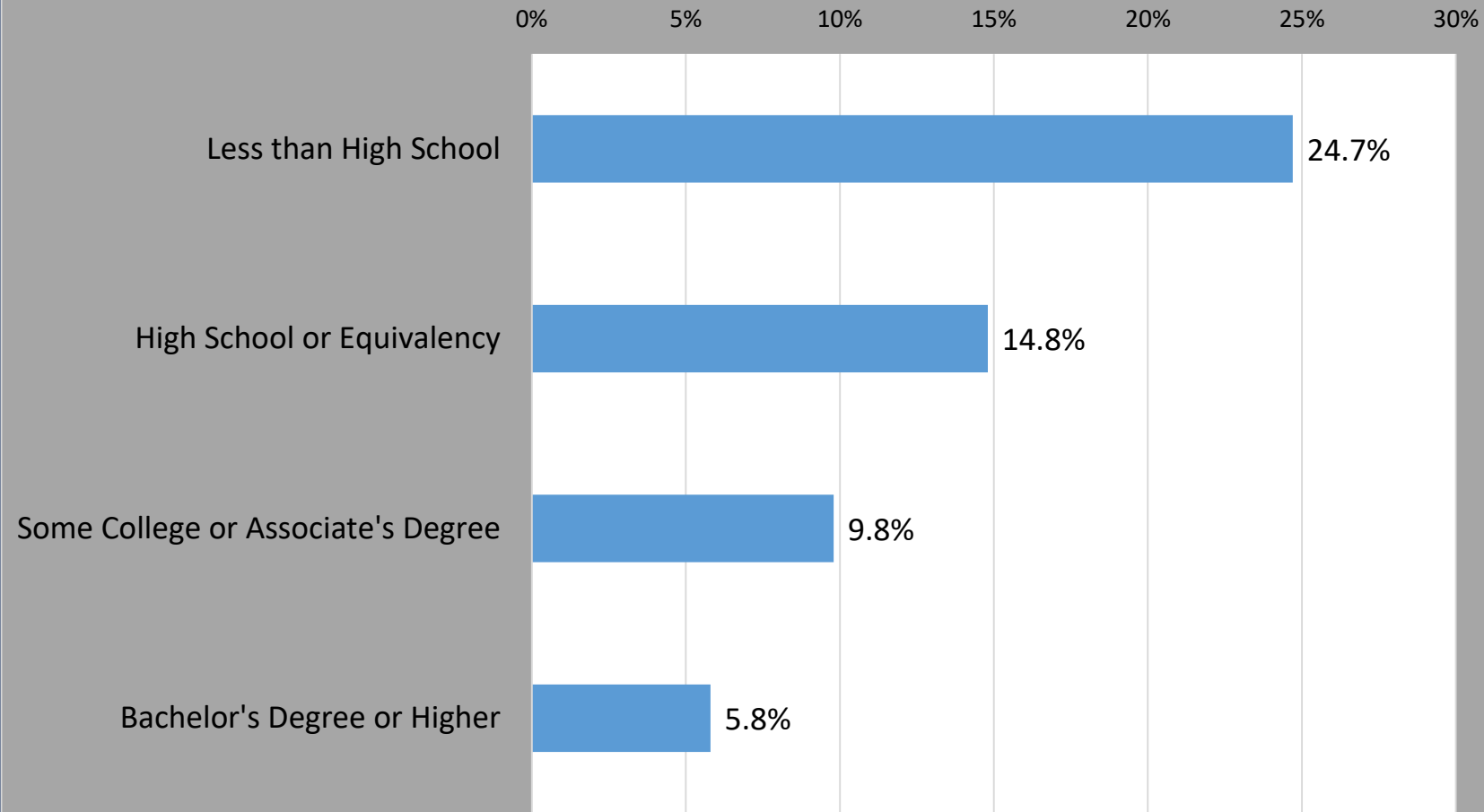


# Percent of Counties, by state, who had more jobs in 2017 than they did in 2007

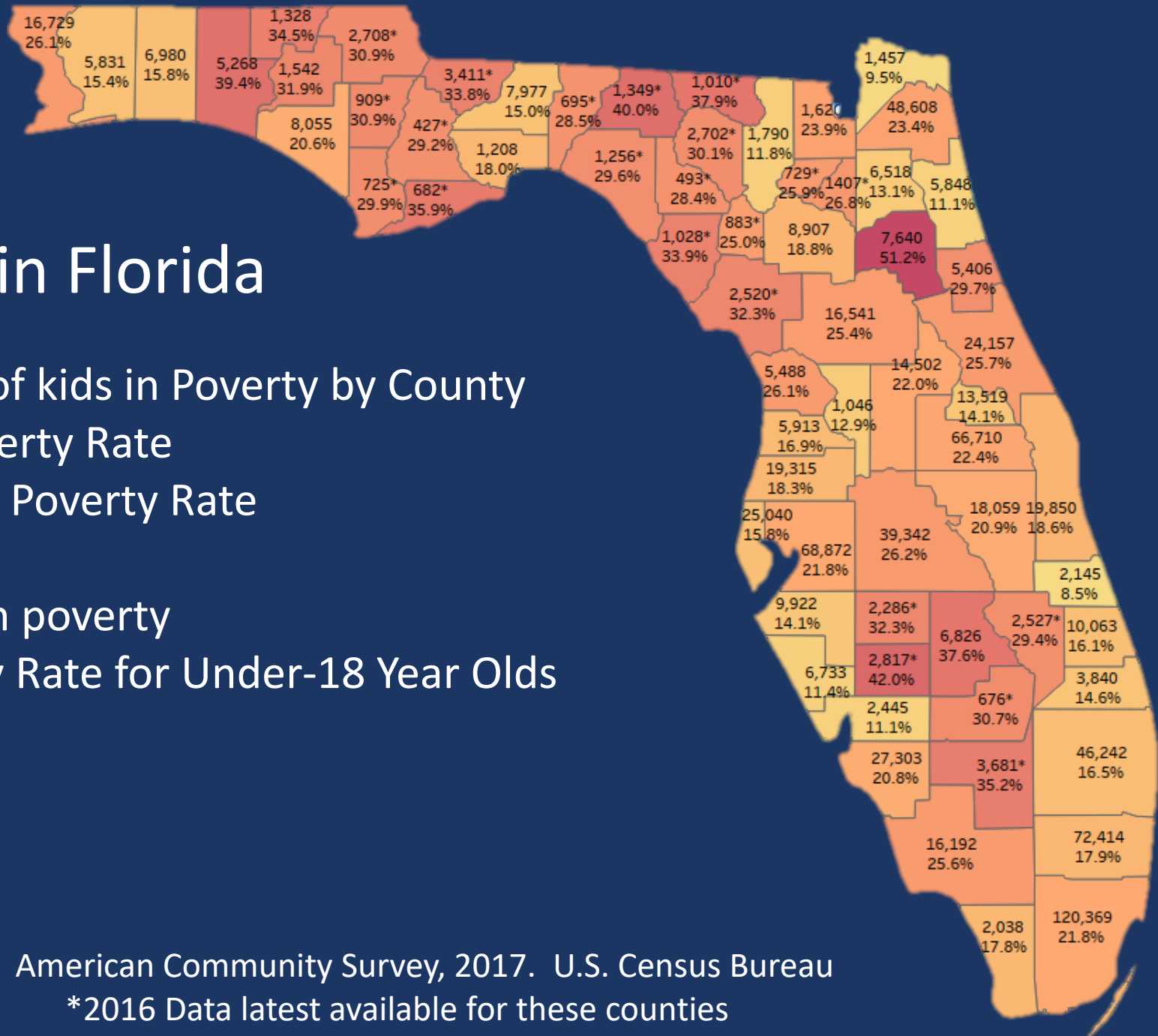

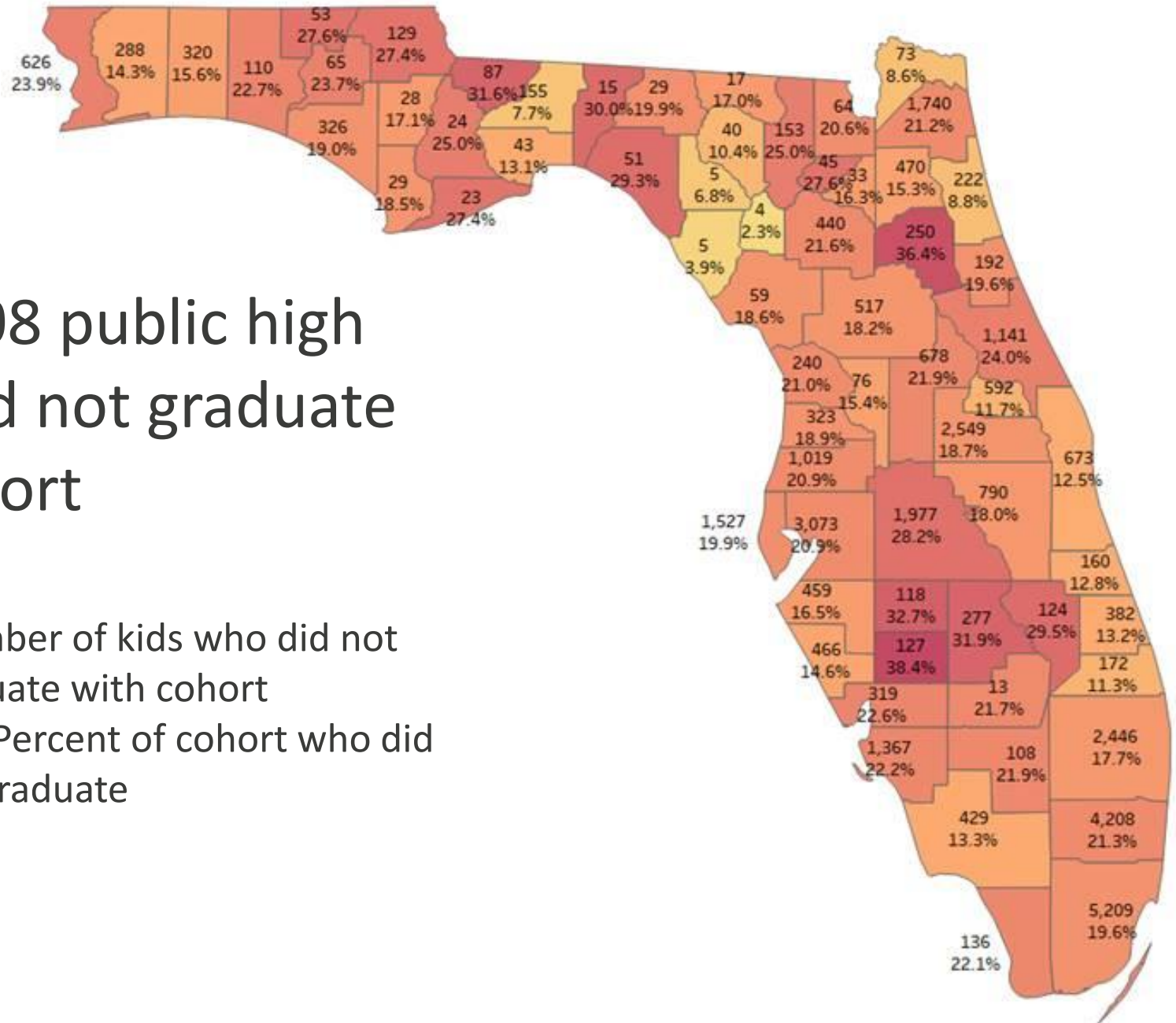

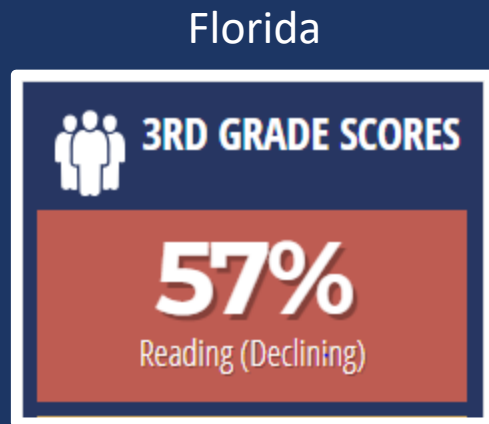

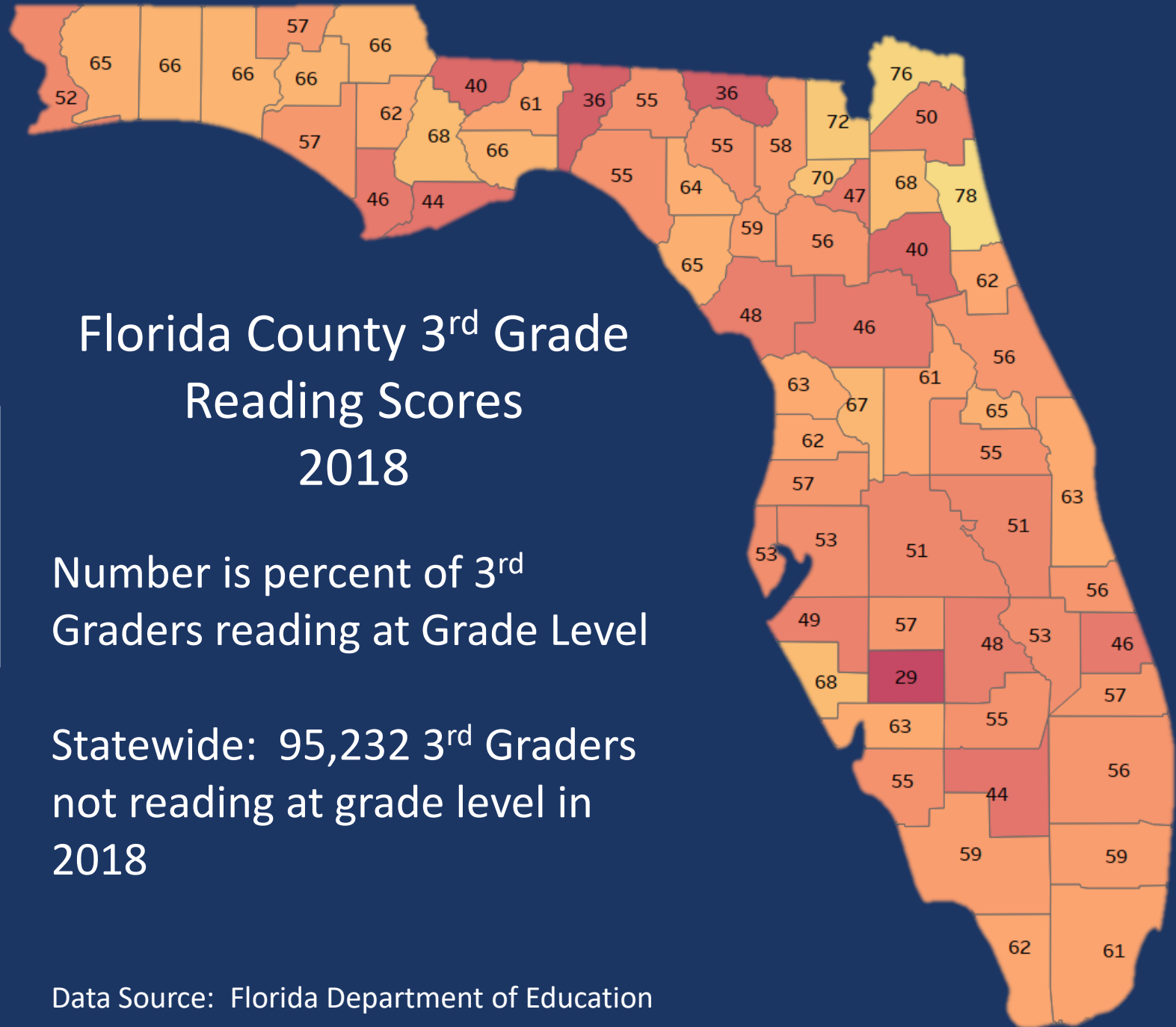


## Florida County 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading Scores 2018
