

IGNITION SEQUENCE START

(Before the first day of class)

- ★ Retention AND persistence
- ★ Set up classroom to be conducive for conversation
- ★ Learn the ins and outs until you feel confident
- Set up Remind and Google Classroom
- * Identify volunteers
- ★ Progress trackers
- ★ Identify classroom responsibilities



WE HAVE A LIPTOPP!

(The first week)

- ★ Provide an orientation
- ★ Gather contact information and birthdays
- ★ Learn names and countries of origin
- ★ Identify obstacles and solutions
- Help students set goals and have a visual pathway towards success
- ★ Lower that affective filter
- ★ Assign a buddy
 - * Assign a responsibility



THE EAGLE HAS LANDED

(Throughout the term)

- ★ Get feedback and give them what they want
- ⋆ Don't be too tough
- ★ Make sure students leave with something every day
- Keep routines but add variety
- ★ Track progress
- ★ Keep in touch
- * Have volunteers work with students 1:1 or in small groups .

(Celebrating success)

- ★ Classroom family concept
- ★ Celebrate just showing up
- ★ Rewards for software usage
- ★ Birthdays/Life events




FAILURE IS NOT AN OPTION

(Setting students up for stop out success)

- ★ Keep in touch
- Post lessons/materials on Google Classroom or send through Remind
- Encourage students to continue with software usage and monitor/provide feedback
- Provide physical materials if technology is not an option
