



#### WHO

Used when referring to people.

(I want to know the person)

#### WHERE

Used when referring to a place or location.
(I want to know the place)

Where is the library? Where do you live?

#### WHEN

Used to refer to a time or an accession.

(I want to know the time)

When is his birthday?
When do the shops open?

#### WHAT

Used to refer to specific information.
(I want to know the thing)

What is your name? What is her job?

#### WHY

Used to obtain an explanation or a reason.

Why are they always late?

(I want to know the reason)

#### HOW

Used to describe the manner that something is done.
(I want to know the way)

How does he know the answer? How do you cook spaghetti?

#### HOW MUCH

Refers to a quantity or a price.

How much time do you have to finish the test? How much is the jacket on display in the window?

#### HOW OFTEN

Why are you angry?

Refers to frequency.

How often does she study? How often do you visit your grandmother?

#### WHICH

to be made.

(I want to know the thing between alternatives)
