Question Words

WHO

Used when referring to **people**.
(I want to know the person)
Who is that strange guy over there?

WHERE

Used when referring to a **place or location**.
(I want to know the place)
Where is the library?
Where do you live?

WHEN

Used to refer to a **time or an occasion**.
(I want to know the time)
When is his birthday?
When do the shops open?

WHAT

Used to refer to **specific information**.
(I want to know the thing)
What is your name?
What is her job?

WHY

Used to obtain an **explanation or a reason**.
(I want to know the reason)
Why are they always late?
Why are you angry?

HOW

Used to describe the **manner that something is done**.
(I want to know the way)
How does he know the answer?
How do you cook spaghetti?

HOW MUCH

Refers to a **quantity or a price**.
How much time do you have to finish the test?
How much is the jacket on display in the window?

HOW OFTEN

Refers to **frequency**.
How often does she study?
How often do you visit your grandmother?

WHICH

Used when a **choice needs to be made**.
(I want to know the thing between alternatives)
Which day do you prefer for a meeting – today or tomorrow?
