Regional Collaboration


To support regional collaboration, FDOE:

- **Provided additional funding of \$45,000 for each grantee.** The additional funds must be used to support activities associated with the technical assistance described to include planning, convening meetings, and travel.
- **Will provide technical assistance** on collaborative approaches to adult education delivery to include virtual and in-person engagements.
- **Will allow a no-cost extension on existing funding** through October 30, 2022 for planning as a result of the technical assistance provided.

Regional Collaboration

Funds increase will support:

- Activities associated with the professional development aimed to promote deeper partnerships among providers and other entities that ensure comprehensive delivery and improved learner outcomes. In addition, funds will support planning, convening meetings, and travel expenditures.
- Allow a **no-cost extension** on existing funding through **October 30, 2022**, for the appropriate planning as a result of technical assistance provided.
- Amendments must be submitted by June 30th.

Integrated Education and Training (IET)

- IET reviews for 2022-2023 RFA submissions are underway.
- We currently have 238 approved IET programs statewide.
- In 2022-2023, we are looking for more detailed programs of study.
 - FDOE Adult Education curriculum framework standards
 - FDOE employability skills
 - Industry certification codes and post-secondary state course numbering system (SCNS) codes.

IET Data Reporting Measurable Skills Gains

- Data Reporting presentations by Brittany Ross shared additional opportunities to earn Measurable Skills Gains (MSGs) through industry certifications and postsecondary courses.
- To earn an IET related MSG for 2021-2022, approved industry certifications and postsecondary courses **must be in the IET Program Number Appendix.**
- Review IET Program Number Appendix by June 17th to prepare for end of year reporting to NRS.

Notable Changes to 2022-2023 FDOE Curriculum Frameworks

- ABE Reading and Language frameworks have been combined to form ABE Reasoning through Language Arts (RLA) course.
- ABE students can now enroll in two courses instead of three (ABE-RLA and ABE-Math).
- Students can be placed by their Reading and/or Language pre-test.
- Measurable skills gains (MSGs) can only occur in subject areas where pre-tests were administered.
- Standalone ABE Reading and ABE Language are daggered for deletion after 2022-2023.

Notable Changes to 2022-2023 FDOE Curriculum Frameworks

- New Employability Skills framework
 - Incorporate these skills into all Adult General Education courses, notably Integrated Education and Training (IET)

Workforce Preparation Activities (Use Employability Frameworks)

“...include activities, programs, or services designed to help an individual acquire a combination of basic academic skills, critical thinking skills, digital literacy skills, and self-management skills, including competencies in:
(a)utilizing resources; (b) using information; (c) working with others;
(d) understanding systems; (e) skills necessary for successful transition into and completion of postsecondary education or training, or employment; and (f) other employability skills that increase an individual’s preparation for the workforce.”

(34 CFR 463.34)
