



Study: Nearly 1 in 4 Students Fails Military Entrance Exam

This 2015 report by The Education Trust bolsters a growing worry among military and education leaders that the pool of young people qualified for military service will grow too small.





The AFQT scores are divided into the following categories and mostly comprised of Arithmetic Reasoning (AR) Mathematics Knowledge (MK)- Paragraph Comprehension (PC) and Word Knowledge (WK)

•Category I: 93-99

•Category II: 65–92

•Category III A: 50-64

•Category III B: 31–49

•Category IV A: 21–30

•Category IV B: 16–20

•Category IV C: 10-15

•Category V: 0-9

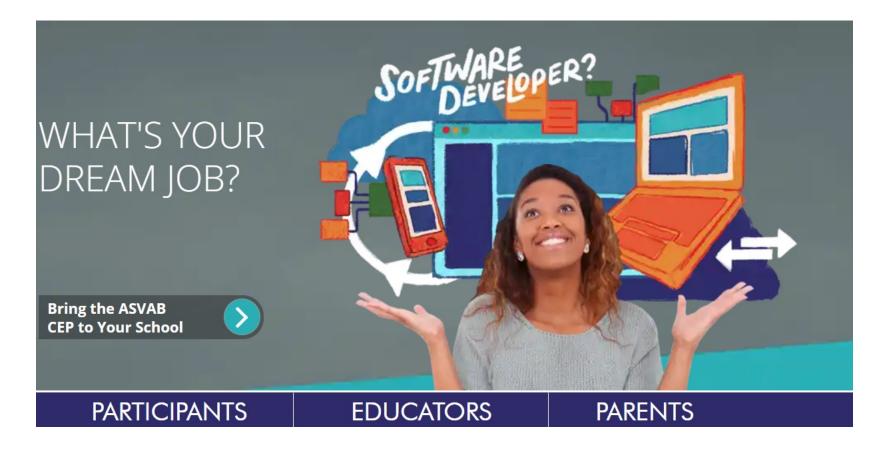

Basic Skills Enhancement Pilot



Problem Statement: 30 % or more potential Military applicants lack the basic skills in math, reading comprehension and vocabulary, to adequately qualify for service based on their current ASVAB scores.

End state: Develop a population of test qualified applicants that improve their score on the ASVAB.

Target Audience: This is a Pre-Future Soldier Prep Course (PFSPC) to improve ASVAB scores.

Program of Instruction (POI): Utilizing the 4 main topics of the Basic Skills Enhancement Program (BSEP) curriculum currently taught at FSPC.
