We follow 5 fictitious students as they seek to upskill their abilities so that they can obtain a job at the Adult Ed Med Hospital.

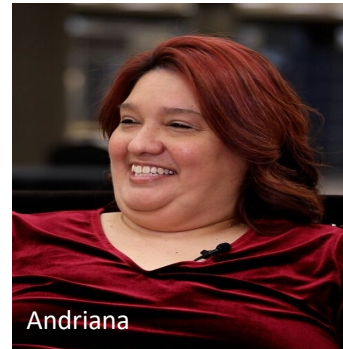
